JUDGEMENT AND ORDER

Plaintiff Vijaya Bank, Aizawl Branch, Aizawl is present through Counsels Shri W.Sam Joseph & other, Advocates.

Today is fixed for appearance of the defendant Mr. Nurul Islam. However, the defendant could not be traced out till date in order to procure his attendance in this court.

The instant Money Suit No.10 of 2005 had been instituted by the plaintiff Bank on 18.03.2005 for recovery of Rs.51,133/- with interest @ 18% w.e.f. 18.03.2005 from the defendant.
