ORDER

The plaintiff had joined the post of Constable Mechanic/fitter under Central Police Workshop at Police Headquarters, Aizawl on 6/11/1990. His resignation letter submitted on 2.12.1992 was accepted under No. E/PHQ/264/91/13 Dt. 2.12.1992. The plaintiff therefore prayed to re-instatement and arrear/allowances during the period from 2.12.1992 till re-instatement etc.

The defendants also vehemently contested in the case by filing written statements stating that the prayer of the plaintiff illegal to realize.

Although the suit is at the stage of evidence of the plaintiff. On perusal of pleadings and evidence adduced by the plaintiff witness, the matter is purely the subject matter jurisdiction of Hon'ble Writ Courts which the jurisdiction of this civil court is ousted as it is purely service matters.

As inevitably and to avoid waste of time and efforts by parties, the suit is dismissed at this stage for want of jurisdiction.

With this order, the case shall stand disposed of.
